I hope you enjoy reading our newsletter.

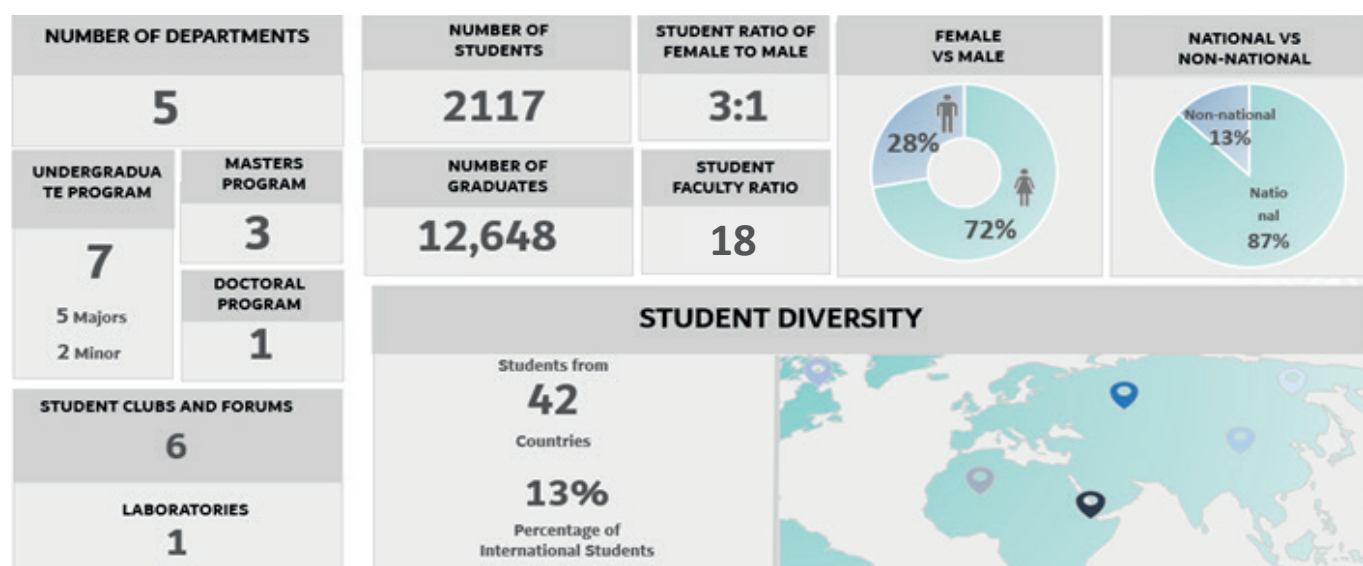

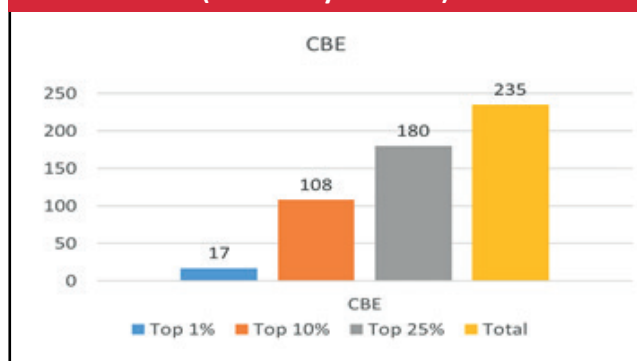

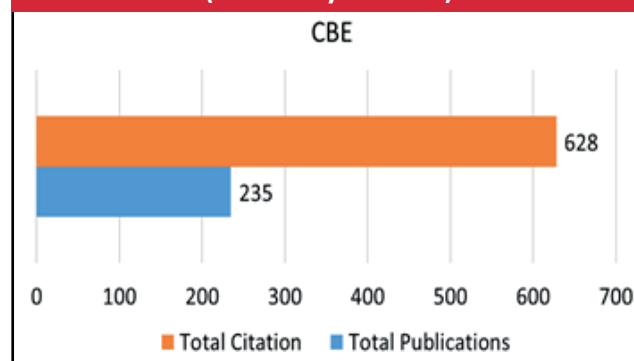

## 5.4 The IEOM Undergraduate Research Competition

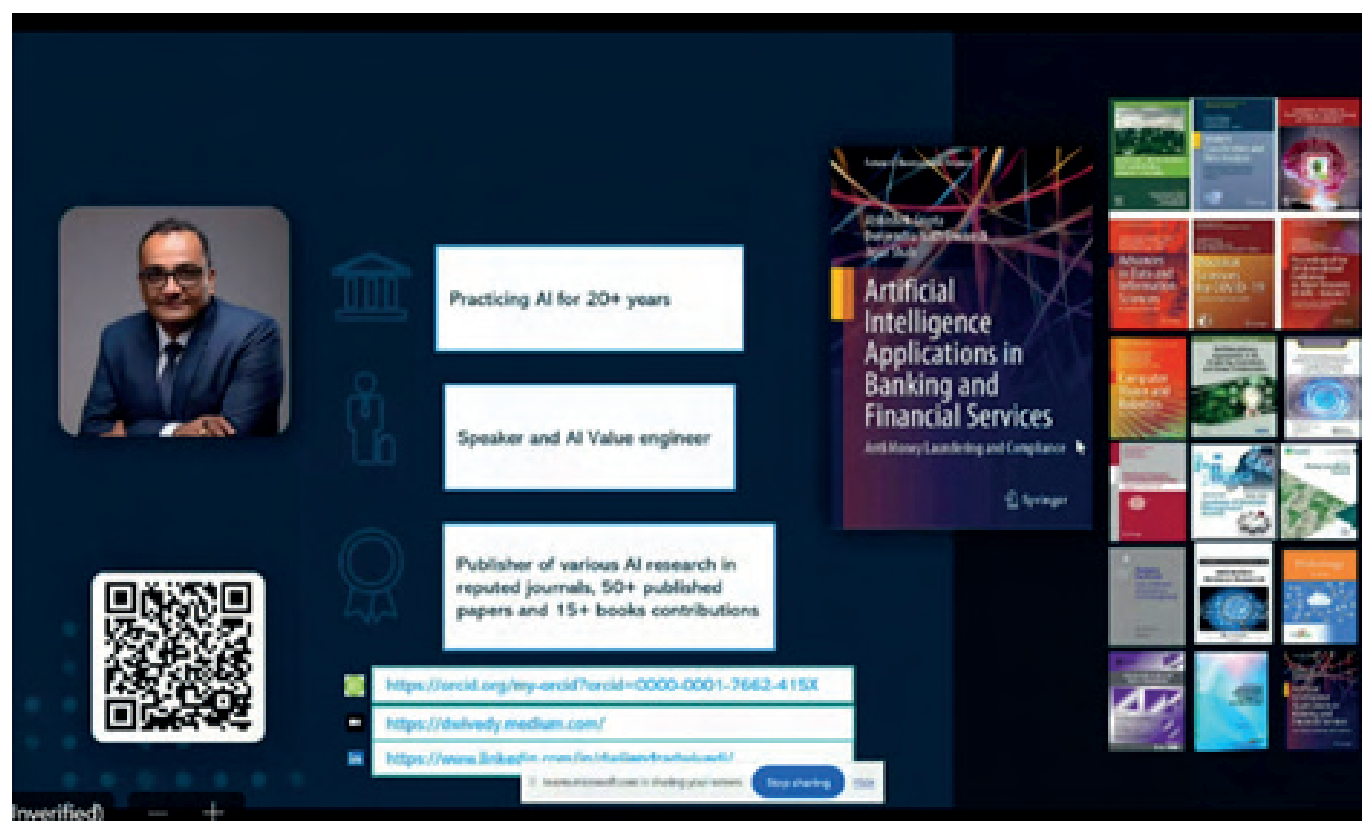
UAEU students Raneem Qwaider, Mariam Almenhali, and Mouza Alkhyeli won second place at the IEOM Undergraduate Research Competition in Oman for their study on how LLMs handle linguistic and mathematical complexity in linear programming. Supervised by Dr. Muhammad Naiman Jalil and supported by the CBE's SURE+ grant, the research found LLMs perform well with mathematical complexity but struggle with complex language.

### 6.2 Chapter Zero UAE: Driving Climate Governance in 2025

The College of Business and Economics at UAEU supports Chapter Zero UAE, a climate governance initiative launched in October 2024 with key partners and aligned with the UAE's Net Zero 2050 strategy. Dr. Cintia Kulzer Sacilotto, CBE Assistant Prof., serves on its Steering Committee of Chapter Zero UAE.

### 6.3 Innovative Work in VR Education and International Higher Education

In December 2024, Dr. Mary Aguilar Legc presented her innovative VR teaching practices at INSEAD's Immersive Learning Workshop in Abu Dhabi, joining experts from top universities to highlight how immersive tech enhances engagement and outcomes in business education.



### 6.4 Research Patents in Innovation, Technology and Entrepreneurship

Mr. Zulficar M. Aslam, inventor and UAEU lecturer, has developed two patented therapeutic technologies. The first, the "Deep Learning Enabled Haptic Holographic Environment," uses AI-powered holograms to support patients facing stress, anxiety, and depression through real-time emotional and physical interaction. It was granted U.S. patent #12208217 on January 8, 2025.



The second is a physiotherapy device titled “System and Method for Controlling a Prosthetic Device,” which uses natural user interfaces and Swarm AI to interpret gestures from unaffected body parts, aiding mobility in 3D environments. It was granted Australian patent #2018236851 on March 7, 2024.

The CBE and the Human Capital Research Center (HCRC) at United Arab Emirates University hosted a thought-provoking symposium on Future-Ready Talent: Navigating the AI and Digital Skills Revolution. The event hosted an exceptional line up of speakers, including keynote addresses from Dr. Na Fu, Prof. of HRM at Trinity College Dublin and Mr. Sultan Alowais, Director of Smart Services at the Prime Minister's Office - UAE. The event also included an insightful panel discussion moderated by Dr. Mohammed Al Waqfi.

A special thank you to the Irish research team, Dr. Steven McCartney from University College Dublin and Dr. Amy Fahy from Maynooth University, who presented their joint research project on "Building

and Managing Talent in Advanced Digital Skills" in collaboration with the HCRC at UAEU, bringing a global perspective to the conversation.

The symposium emphasized key themes such as the critical need for advanced digital skills, the ethical and strategic integration of AI, and the importance of cross-sector collaboration to prepare the workforce for a rapidly evolving digital landscape. These insights serve as a foundation for driving innovation and workforce readiness in the UAE and beyond.



## 7.2 Sino-Arab Innovation & Entrepreneurship Forum: Bridging Cultures, Building Futures

The Sino-Arab Innovation & Entrepreneurship Forum, held at UAE University (Feb 2025), brought together a vibrant blend of academic minds, tech innovators, and entrepreneurial leaders from across the Arab world and China. Hosted in collaboration with the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (Guangzhou) and UAEU's College of Business and Economics, the forum proved to be a dynamic platform for cross-cultural dialogue and strategic partnerships.

The forum began with opening remarks from Prof. Lionel M. Ni, Founding President of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (Guangzhou), and Prof. Maurizio Sobrero, Director of the Emirates Center for Entrepreneurship Research at the United Arab Emirates University (UAEU). Their keynote addresses set the tone for the day—Prof. Ni highlighted the vital role of international collaboration in addressing global challenges, while Prof. Sobrero discussed entrepreneurship models tailored to the unique dynamics of regional ecosystems.

The forum featured two dynamic panel discussions. The first panel, Entrepreneurship Education in the AI Era, was moderated by Prof. Weijia Wen of HKUST and included Dr. Rima bin Saeed from King Saud University (Saudi Arabia), Dr. Ashraf A. Bany Mohammed (Jordan), Prof. Said Elbanna from Qatar University, Prof. Huihe Qiu of HKUST, and Dr. Paul Savage of UAEU. The second panel, Innovation & Ecosystem Development, was chaired by Dr. Saeed Aldahmani of UAEU and featured Dr. Giovanni Pau from the Autonomous Robotics Center in Abu Dhabi, Prof. Ge Lin Kan of HKUST, Mr. Saeed Alnofeli of In5 (Dubai), Mr. Salem Alshamsi from Ma'an (Abu Dhabi), and Ms. Xin Xiong of the Zhongkan Beidou Research Institute (China).
