GRADUATION

The following data represent the graduation rates for the College of Education's initial-licensure programs: Early Childhood Education (ECE), Special Education (SPED), and Health & Physical Education (HPE).

A. Number of Completers

Table 1 shows number of completers in the last three academic years. From Academic Year 2021-2022 to Academic Year 2023-2024, there was an average of 105 completers.

In Fall 2023 and Spring 2024, there were a total of 96 completers. Of these, 49% completed the ECE program, 40% completed the SPED program, and 11% completed the HPE program (*see Table 1 and Figure 2*).




Figure 1 Number of ECE, HPE, & SPED Completers from AY2021/2022 to AY 2023-2024




Figure 2 Number of ECE, HPE, & SPED Completers during Fall 2021 & Spring 2022




Figure 3 BS Level Six-year Graduation Rates




Figure 4 ECE Program Six-year Graduation Rates




Figure 5 SPED Program Six-year Graduation Rates




Figure 6 HPE Program Six-year Graduation Rates
