

GRADUATION

The following data represent the graduation rates for the College of Education's initial-licensure programs: Early Childhood Education (ECE), Special Education (SPED), and Health & Physical Education (HPE).

A. Number of Completers

Table 1 shows number of completers in the last three academic years. From Academic Year 2022-2023 to Academic Year 2024-2025, there was an average of 105 completers.

In Fall 2024 and Spring 2025, there were a total of 81 completers. Of these, 54% completed the ECE program, 33% completed the SPED program, and 12% completed the HPE program (see Table 1 and Figure 2).

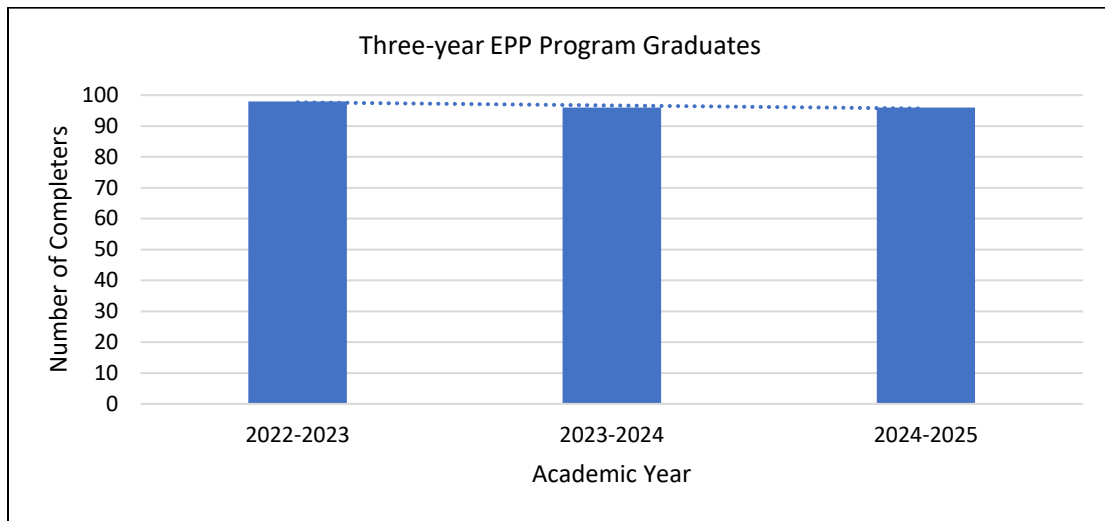


Figure 1 Number of EPP Completers from AY2022/2023 to AY 2024-2025

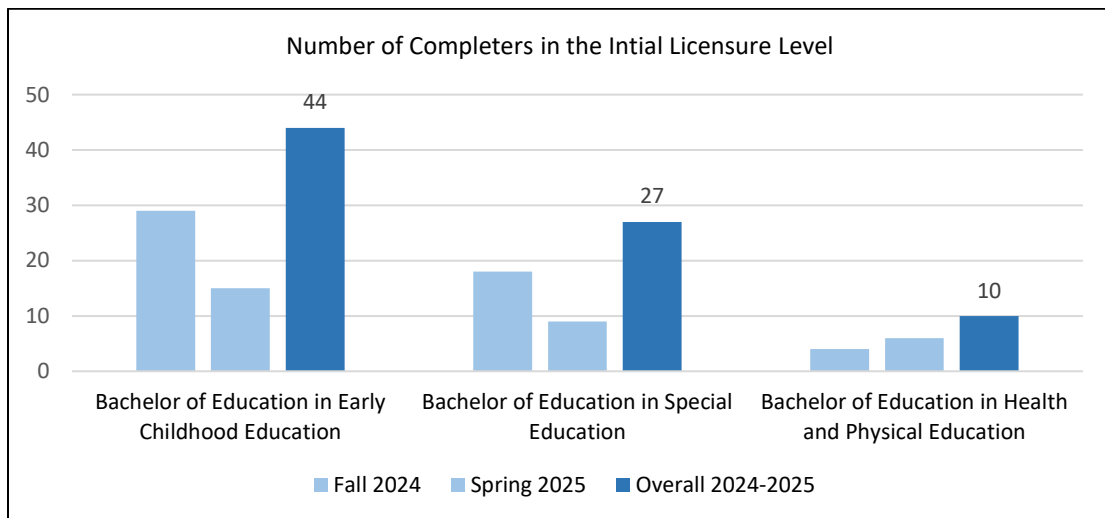


Figure 2 Number of ECE, HPE, & SPED Completers during Fall 2024 & Spring 2025

B. Graduation Rates

The data presented below demonstrates the six-year graduation rates for initial-licensure programs beginning with the 2014-2015 academic year. Notably, the Early Childhood Education program achieved its highest graduation rate of 90% in the 2018-2019 cohort, Special Education reached a peak of 97% in the 2015-2016 cohort, and Health and Physical Education saw its highest rate of 88% in the 2019-2020 cohort.

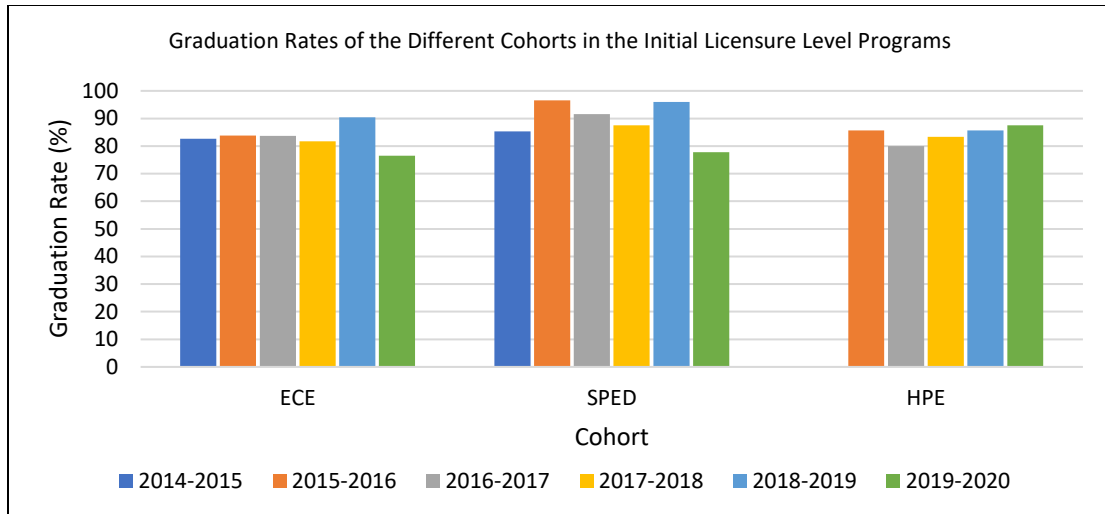


Figure 3 BS Level Six-year Graduation Rates

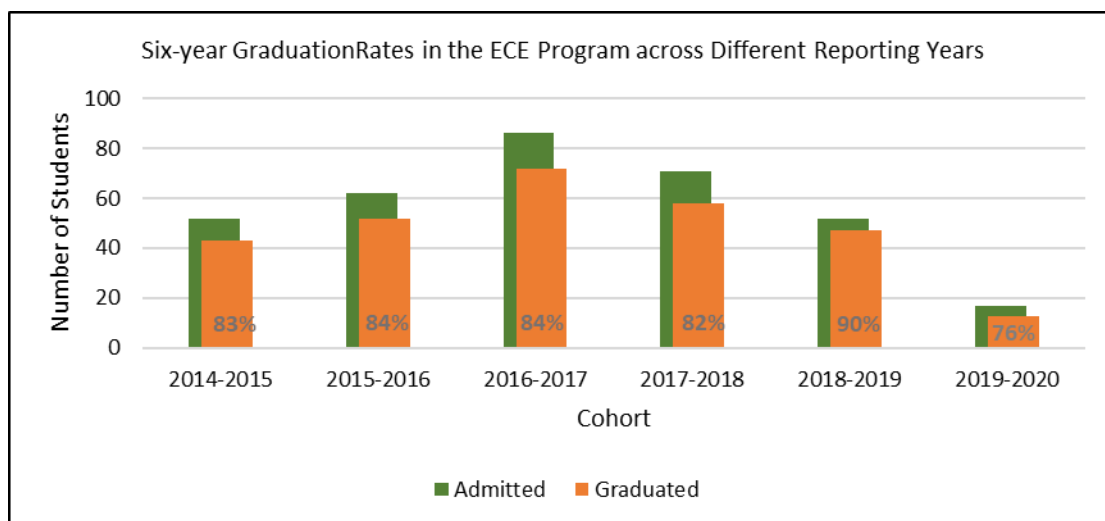


Figure 4 ECE Program Six-year Graduation Rates

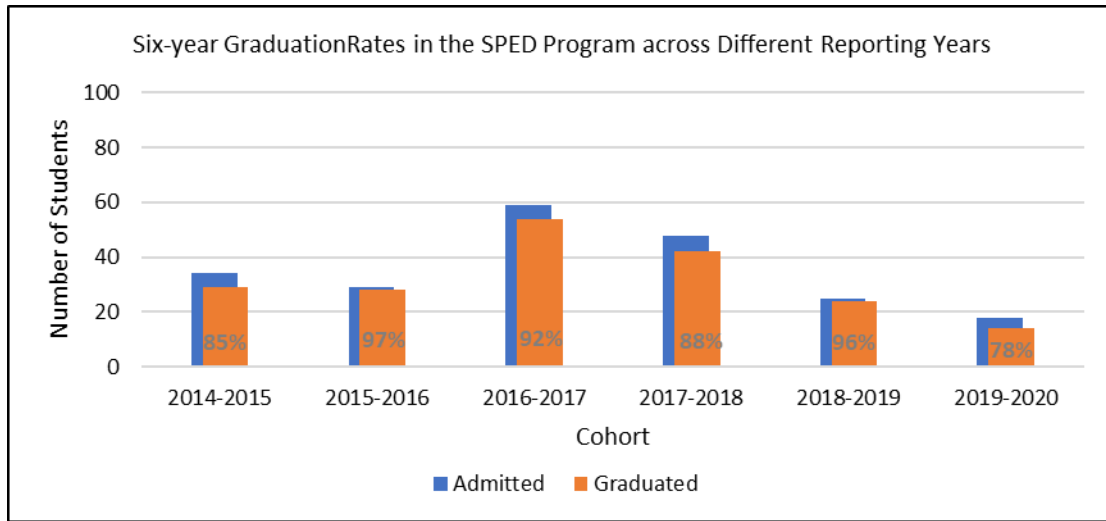


Figure 5 SPED Program Six-year Graduation Rates

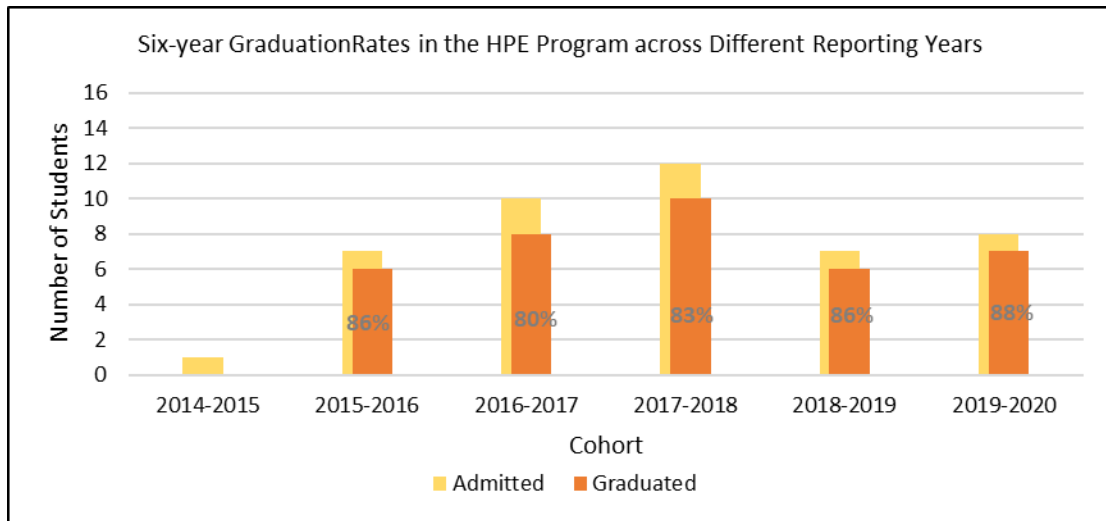


Figure 6 HPE Program Six-year Graduation Rates
