Research projects:

Two PhD studentships available in the Department of Medical Microbiology and Immunology (Viral Pathology Laboratory, Prof Gulfaraz Khan) investigating the role of Epstein-Barr virus in the pathogenesis of Multiple sclerosis.

Requirement:

- Must have a Bachelor and Master's degrees (minimum GPA: 3.0/4.00 for BSc and 3.50/4.00 for MSc.)
- At least one of the degrees should be in: Veterinary Medicine, Medicine, Biomedical Science, Biological Science or closely related fields.
- Have an interest in virology and viral pathology.
- Have a score of at least 6.5 on the IELTS or an equivalent TOFEL score.
- Experience in working with animal models would be an advantage.
