 - Applied Track 85% (Speech-Language Pathology only).
 - SABIS 80%.
 - ASP 85%.
- A minimum score of (900) in EmSAT Mathematics or equivalent mathematics readiness tests including Advanced Placement (AP) with a minimum score of (3),
- International Baccalaureate (IB-High Level Exam) with a minimum score of (5),
- General Certificate of Education (GCE) with a minimum score of (C), or Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) with a minimum score of (590) or passing the bridging (prerequisite) course.
- A minimum Score of (900) in EmSAT Biology or Chemistry, or Physics or equivalent related science subjects' readiness tests including Advanced Placement (AP) with a minimum score of (3),
- International Baccalaureate (IB-High Level Exam) with a minimum score of (5), or General Certificate of Education (GCE) with a minimum score of (C).
- Complete Basic Biology I (BIOC100) and General Chemistry I (CHEM 111) in the first two semesters with a grade of C or above (For Nutritional Science & Dietetics).
- Complete Basic Biology I (BIOC100) and General Physics (PHYS105) in the first two semesters with a grade of C or above (For Speech-Language Pathology).
